- Provide individualized services in the general education setting and special education setting.
- Assess individual speech/language needs of students and make data-driven recommendations.
- Certify student disabilities in accordance with state and federal guidelines.
- Evaluate student progress in relation to treatment and report data-driven progress to parents/guardians and staff.
- Prepare individual educational programs, additional plans, and materials to address student needs.
- Plan, implement and deliver an effective program of speech and language services.
- Maintain accurate and current student records.
- Collaborate with school staff to provide effective programs for students.
- Consult with parents to integrate home and school goals.
- Consult with school and system administrators regarding program integration, speech, language, hearing services, and other matters.
- Provide training to colleagues as needed for appropriate within the realm of speech and language educational needs.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the School Principal(s) and the Supervisor of Special Education.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

• **PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** Must be able to see, hear, and move quickly enough to provide for the safety and instructional needs of the children. Must be able to articulate clearly. Must be physically active and interactive throughout the school day. Must be able to stand for extended periods of time, stoop, bend, do light lifting, push, pull, step, and have

good finger dexterity. Must have emotional coping skills appropriate for the management of student behavior.
